

Some reminders from SC Law Regarding Motorcycles:

The Highway Patrol reminds motorcyclists and motor vehicle drivers of some important points from South Carolina law regarding motorcycles **SECTION 56-5-3640 and 3660.**

- All motorcycles are entitled to full use of a lane and no motor vehicle shall be driven in such a manner as to deprive any motorcycle of the full use of a lane. This shall not apply to motorcycles operated two abreast in a single lane.
- The operator of a motorcycle shall not overtake and pass in the same lane occupied by the vehicle being overtaken.
- No person shall operate a motorcycle between lanes of traffic, or between adjacent lines or rows of vehicles.
- Motorcycles shall not be operated more than two abreast in a single lane.
- Helmets and goggles are required for operators under 21.
