SUBJECT: Law Enforcement Training Events

NW3C, the National White Collar Crime Center, will be conducting the following cost-free training events for state, local, and tribal law enforcement in on September 20-23, 2016, in North Charleston:

- Macintosh® Triage and Imaging – Officers will be introduced to the various models of Apple® hardware that will most likely be encountered during an investigation and to the OS X® operating system; they will learn basic skills necessary to navigate and utilize both the graphical and command line interfaces.
- Apple iDevice Forensics – Officers will learn methods for acquiring data from iOS devices (iPod Touch®, iPhone®, and iPad®); will use forensically sound tools and techniques to analyze potential evidence from iOS devices; and will learn methods for gaining access to a locked device.
