The Law Enforcement Coordinating Committee (*Office of U. S. Attorney*) South Carolina Law Enforcement Officers' Association, and LECC Drug Subcommittee in conjunction with South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy

will host a four and one-half day school for South Carolina law enforcement commanders, or individuals who are expected to be in a position of leadership within the next two years – **Lieutenant or higher**. This class is designed to provide the law enforcement commander with an understanding of challenges and management issues in 21st Century policing. This course provides supervisors and managers with necessary tools to enhance the performance of the work unit and examines critical areas that relate to one's ability to be both a leader and a manager. Additionally, attendees receive practical information and tips from experienced South Carolina law enforcement practitioners serving as instructors. The class also provides information on current trends as well as an understanding of the benefits of working with state and federal agencies and potential resources these agencies bring to the table.

Eligibility:

South Carolina Law Enforcement Commanders, or individuals who are expected to be in a position of leadership within the next two years – **Lieutenant or higher rank**. (NOTE: Students are selected by the LECC Drug Subcommittee to attend this class. Four alternates will also be selected; therefore, agencies do **not** have the option to substitute officers if it is necessary for a selected officer to cancel.)
