



Do you know when to stop for a school bus?

Two-Lane Road



On TWO-LANE roads, motorists traveling in BOTH directions must stop for a school bus with flashing amber/red lights.

Four-Lane Road



On FOUR OR MORE lane roads, motorists APPROACHING a school bus from the OPPOSITE direction on a roadway do not have to stop.

REMEMBER

The minimum fine for passing a stopped school bus:

1st Offense - \$500 (and 6 points)

2nd Offense - \$2,000 (and 6 points)

When you see flashing lights on a school bus, slow down, prepare to stop, and **ALWAYS LOOK FOR CHILDREN!**
